EMTEK GROUP SUCCEEDS TO COLLECT Rp15,838,513,884 IN “INDONESIA TANGGUH CHARITY CONCERT”

All Donations, Proceeds from Sales of Athlete Memorabilia, and Sponsorships Will Be Distributed to Assist the Operation of the COVID-19 Floating Centralized Isolation Ship

PT ELANG MAHKOTA TEKNOLOGI, Tbk (EMTEK) which houses **SCTV, INDOSIAR, O'Channel** and **Vidio.com** last afternoon (**Sunday, 8 August 2021**) successfully held the “**Indonesia Tangguh Charity Concert**” which was broadcast simultaneously on the private TV stations **SCTV, INDOSIAR, and O'Channel** as well as the **Vidio** application. “**Indonesia Tangguh Charity Concert**” managed to raise a total of **Rp15,838,513,884**. On this occasion, **Mr. Budi Karya Sumadi as Minister of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia** who is also the initiator of the procurement of the **Floating Centralized Isolation Ship** for COVID-19 patients, invites the public to be more concerned about the surrounding environment in the midst of the current pandemic condition by donating to those exposed to COVID-19 and medical personnel who continue to struggle. The “**Floating Centralized Isolation Ship**” (**Floating Centralized Isolation**) for COVID-19 patients was initiated by the **Ministry of SOEs and the Government of Indonesia** which has also spent a large amount of money on the procurement of Floating Centralized Isolation in Makassar, Medan, Padang, Palembang, Lampung, Balikpapan, Bitung, and

Ginting, Windy Cantika and Rahmat Erwin Abdullah took part by selling their memorabilia to be donated at the Indonesia Tangguh Charity Concert. **Windy Cantika Aisah** became the first athlete to successfully sell the **Red Lifting Suit** that wore while fighting at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, worth **Rp1 billion**, purchased by **BRI**. Then followed by **Rahmat Erwin Abdullah** who took off the **Black Lifting Suit** for **Rp500 million**, bought by **PLN**. Meanwhile, a pair of historic shoes that led **Anthony Sinisuka Ginting** to win a bronze medal in the Badminton Olympics Tokyo 2020 Men's Singles sport were successfully sold for **Rp500 million**, purchased by **BCA**. Furthermore, **Eko Yuli Irawan's Red Lifting Suit**, which brought him a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, was successfully sold for **Rp1.5 billion**, purchased by **BUKALAPAK**.

The Gold Medal winner at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics who succeeded in making the Indonesian people proud and touched for the struggle of the **Indonesian Badminton Women's Doubles pair, Greysia Polii and Apriyani Rahayu** also participated in the **Indonesia Tangguh Charity Concert**. **A pair of shoes** belonging to **Greysia Polii** that brought her a gold medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics were successfully sold for **Rp1 billion** to **Mandiri Bank**. Followed by **a pair of shoes** belonging to **Apriyani Rahayu** who was also successfully released worth **Rp1 billion** to **Telkom Indonesia**. All proceeds from the sale of these memorabilia will be donated to help with the operational costs of the "**Floating Centralized Isolation Ship**" (**Floating Centralized Isolation**) for COVID-19 patients.

Mr. Sutanto Hartono as **Managing Director of EMTEK Group** said that the EMTEK Group was called when the initiation of the use of PELNI's passenger ship used for floating centralized self-isolation for COVID-19 patients was sparked. EMTEK Group stated its readiness to become a partner of the Indonesian Ministry of Transportation under the leadership of Mr. Budi Karya Sumadi and the Indonesian Ministry of SOEs under the leadership of Mr. Erick Thohir to raise funds from corporations to the wider community so that this effort can be carried out properly.
